On February 16, 1999 signed petitions requesting the study a subordinate service district for sewer service for property owners on Lake Chippewa was presented to the Brandon Township Board of Supervisors.

Separate petitions were presented by the Devils/Little Chip Lake Association at the same time.

In accordance with state law, the Supervisors scheduled a public hearing to discuss this issue.

Meeting Date is Saturday, March 13 at 10:00 A.M. in the auditorium at Brandon City Hall.

An engineer from Widseth, Smith, & Nolting will make a presentation concerning this study from a cost and technical point of view. This firm has recent experience in the local area with other systems bordering on lakes, such as Lake Mary.

This meeting will give all interested parties an opportunity to voice their concerns and opinions and learn more about the proposed process, estimated costs per property owner, and the possibility of grant monies to offset the study costs and sewer system cost.

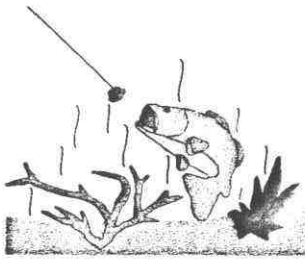
